## All Saints' Day

All Saints' Day (also known as All Hallows' Day or Halloween) is the day after [All Hallows' Eve](#) (Hallowe'en). It is a feast day celebrated on **1st November** by [Anglicans](#) and [Catholics](#).

It is an opportunity for believers to remember all saints and martyrs, known and unknown, throughout Christian history.

## All Souls' Day

All Souls' Day is marked on **2nd November** (or the **3rd** if the 2nd is a Sunday), directly following All Saints' Day, and is an opportunity for Catholics and Anglo-Catholic churches to commemorate the faithful departed. They remember and pray for the souls of people who gone to their eternal reward. Reasoning behind this stems from the notion that when a soul leaves the body, it is not entirely cleansed from venial (minor) sins. However, through the power of prayer and self-denial, the faithful left on earth may be able to help these souls gain the Beatific Vision they seek, bringing the soul eternal sublime happiness.
